# Information Packet PPE Academy and Science Olympiad

Dear Parent/Guardian,

Pershing Park will be starting an academy for third, fourth and fifth grade students. Your child has expressed an interest in being in a Pershing Park Academy or Science Olympiad.

Students who would like to improve academically may now come to the PPE Academy for math, reading, writing, & science. We will be using project-based learning, STEM, maker space, higher level Literature Circles to increase comprehension, intensive writing and book creating, as well as our competitive Science Olympiad.

We will meet on Mondays from 3:15 - 4:15 p.m. On meeting days, students will report to the designated room after the bell rings at 3:00. Students will be dismissed at 4:15 at the designated dismissal area out front using the valet service. Our first meeting is on October  $21^{st}$ .

#### Please review the following requirements with your child:

- 1. Attend all practices. **Two** absences will result in dismissal. Conflicting K.I.S.D. activities will not count as an absence. Students may not attend practice if they are absent from school that day due to illness. Students who have excessive unexcused absences from school will not be able to participate.
- 2. Your child must be picked up promptly. For the safety of your child, we do not permit students to walk home after. Buses are <u>not</u> provided, so please arrange for your child to be picked up at PPE no later than 4:15. Students who are picked up more than 15 minutes late, twice, will be dropped from the academy. If a parent/guardian is over thirty minutes late for pick up at any time, the student will be dismissed from the academy. Please have your car tag visible and we will bring your child to you. If you are walking, parents MUST bring a photo I.D. when they come for pick up. Children will only be released to adults listed on the student's registration card who have a photo I.D or to the car with the tag. If you need to add an adult to the registration card, please do so in the Pershing Park front office. We cannot provide supervision for siblings. Please make sure siblings understand how to get home in the afternoons.
- 3. Negative behavior will not be tolerated. Students are accountable for their behavior at all times. Only positive attitudes will be accepted in the academy or Science Olympiad. If a student receives a serious code of conduct violation after the due date for the academy permission slip, he/she will be removed. Non-serious code of conduct violations will place a student on probation. If the student receives any additional non-serious or serious referrals, he or she will be

dismissed. All bus referrals will be addressed by the after-school committee. Please remember that students are subject to the student code of conduct during after-school activities as well.

- 4. Good sportsmanship is required for PPE Academy and Science Olympiad. We do not tease our team members or other schools' team members. We are expected to applaud everyone and congratulate everyone on his or her performance. We do not speak negatively to other teams.
- 5. If a parent/guardian withdraws a child from the after-school academy or Science Olympiad, the student will be unable to re-enter the academy for the current school year.
- 6. If your child no longer wants to attend meetings or be part of an academy or Science Olympiad please let us know by calling the front office or sending a note with your child.
