- Proposal moves approx. 345 students from Duncan to Oveta Culp Hobby; 377 live in affected areas
- Proposal moves approx. 73 students from Duncan to Meadows; 79 live in affected areas
- Proposal moves approx. 90 students from Oveta Culp Hobby to Meadows; 97 live in affected areas
- This proposal will close Duncan and spread out students to better use the other affected campuses.
- The EE to 3rd grade students in Duncan's current attendance zone will be zoned to Oveta Culp Hobby
- The 4th and 5th grade students from Duncan and Hobby attendance zones will be zoned to Meadows (just like Clarke's zone)
- Grandfathering for affected, current year 4th graders will not be possible since Duncan would be closed
- Grandfathering, Special Programs and Transfers will impact the effects of rezoning and final enrollment numbers
