**Summer School is an accelerated instructional program; therefore, instructional time is protected by establishing and enforcing high standards for attendance and for behavior.**

**Attendance rules:**

- Students who arrive after 8:20 a.m. will be counted tardy. Three tardies will count as one absence.
- Students arriving after 8:30 a.m. will be counted absent.
- Two (2) days are the maximum number of days a student can be absent and still receive credit. On the 3rd absence, the student will be withdrawn from Summer School and the opportunity to earn promotion will be forfeited.

**Behavior rules:**

- Each summer school will establish classroom rules that focus on 3 expectations for all students:
  1. **Be responsible**
  2. **Be respectful**
  3. **Be safe**
- Students who choose to ignore the classroom rules will receive 1 warning and 1 refocus prior to an office referral.
- If a student receives more than 2 office referrals, he/she may no longer attend Summer School. If attending Summer School to earn promotion, he/she forfeits the opportunity to do so.
- The following critical violations will result in an immediate office referral:
  - Fighting or threatening to fight
  - Damaging or destroying student, teacher, or school property
  - Overtly refusing to follow directions or do school work
  - Engaging in behavior that creates an unsafe situation or shuts down the teacher's ability to continue to teach

**Students are expected to adhere to the Killeen ISD Student Code of Conduct.**

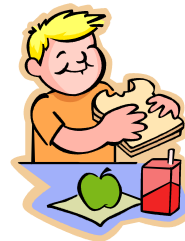


**Summer School Transportation**  
KISD bus transportation is available from the student's neighborhood campus to the host campus each morning, and from the host campus to the neighborhood campus each afternoon.

Students who ride the summer school bus daily will be placed on the bus every day unless a parent or guardian provides a written and signed note detailing a change of transportation. To ensure student safety, transportation changes cannot be made by phone.

The KISD Student Code of Conduct applies to student behavior while riding the bus, waiting for the bus at the home school, and waiting for parent pick-up in the afternoon.

Students who are not picked up within 10 minutes of school dismissal or bus arrival at the home school on more than 2 occasions may no longer attend Summer School. If the student is attending Summer School to earn promotion, he/she forfeits the opportunity to do so.



The KISD School Nutrition Program provides, at no charge, a nutritious breakfast and lunch for all Summer School students.

Students will follow the KISD dress code.  
Uniforms are not required.
