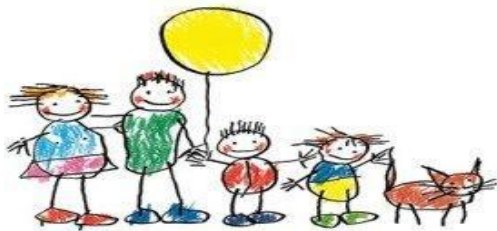

For Kids' Sake



Divorce is a very painful and confusing experience for all children. Research indicates that the manner in which parents handle the situation can have an effect on how children will adjust.



Children of all ages feel the effects of divorce.

Even the most caring parents will find it difficult to focus on the needs of their children during such a traumatic time in the life of the family.

Most parents will not have all the skills that are necessary to help their children through the change and feelings of loss.

For Kids' Sake seminars help put parents in touch with their children's needs and provide them with the knowledge and skills to safely nurture children through the process of divorce.

The **four-hour seminar** is an educational model presented by *professionals who are highly skilled and caring*. It does not deal with personal or legal issues, nor is it a counseling experience. The overwhelming majority of parents who have participated in this type of seminar feel that it is a supportive and worthwhile experience.

Who attends FKS seminars?

Any interested parent, potential foster parent, or professional may attend the seminars. Parents involved in a divorce, motion to modify, or other suits that involve the parent / child relationship and individuals required by their district court to attend such a class are candidates for participation.
