The goal of the STEM Academy is to support a diverse learning community based on common interests. The STEM Academy supports students in developing a vision of future academic and career possibilities and enables students to translate those visions into the realities of college graduation, informed citizenship, and international leadership.

All students in the Killeen ISD attendance zone who are in grades 6-8 during the **2021-2022** school year are eligible to apply. Students who submit a completed application will be included in the lottery selection process. This lottery will determine which students will be offered enrollment in the STEM Academy. Students not selected will be placed on a waiting list.
