We can provide your student:

- Simple First Aid Treatment
- Emergency Treatment
- Temperature Check
- · Give medication with a Physician Order
- Exclude your student from school if shots are

NOT up to date

- Help you find health resources in the community
- Provide education about health related issues

We will send your student home:

- Temperature greater than 100.0F
- Excessive vomiting
- Evidence of a contagious disease

Screenings held throughout the year:

- Vision and Hearing for any student new to Texas Schools
- Vision and Hearing for Pre-K, Kinder, 1st, 3rd and 5th grades

The policy regarding student(s) with a fever states, "Students will now be excluded from school until fever free without use of fever suppressing medications for 24 hours if they have a temperature equal to or greater than 100 degrees." Killeen ISD follows Texas Administration Title 25 for Diseases requiring exclusion from school.

Immunizations must be up to date according to the State of Texas Department of Health and Human Services. Please visit their website for more information.

The Texas Immunization requirements for all incoming Pre-K students are:

EE-Pre-K (2-4 year olds)

DPT/DTaP/DT-4 doses

Polio-3 doses

MMR-1 dose on/after the 1st birthday 6, 7

HIB-1 dose on/after 15 months or 3 doses with the 3rd dose given on/after

1st birthday and at least 2 mths since dose #2.6 **Not required after 5th birthday.**

Hepatitis B-3 doses ⁷

Varicella-1 dose on or after 1st birthday or history of chicken pox 3, 6, 7

Hepatitis A- 2 doses on or after 1st birthday ^{6,7,10} **Must allow 18 months between doses.**

Pneumococcal-1 dose on or after 24 months <u>or</u> 3 or 4 doses with last dose on or after 12 months or 2 doses with both doses on or after 1st birthday.⁶ Not required after 5th birthday.

HIB and Pneumococcal are not required after the child turns 5 years old

The Texas Immunization requirements for all other incoming elementary students are:

Kindergarten-Grades 1-6

DPT-5 doses (with 1 on or after 4th birthday) <u>or</u> 4 doses if one dose is on/after the 4th birthday 6 **Students 7 years or older**:

■ 3 doses of DTP/DTaP/DT with 1 dose on or after 4th birthday.6

Polio-4 doses with one on/after 4th birthday <u>or</u> 3 doses if one dose is on/after the 4th birthday⁶ **MMR**- 2 doses on/after 1st birthday ^{6, 7}

Hepatitis A - 2 doses on/after 1st birthday. 6,7,10 Must allow 18 months between doses.

Hepatitis B-3 doses 4, 7

Varicella--2 doses on/after 1st birthday, or history of chicken pox 3,6,7
