Enrollment Documentation Exceptions



- ➤ Is your residence or housing uncertain?
- Do you lack a permanent physical address?
- ➤ Do you live at a temporary address?

If you live under one of the following conditions, you <u>may</u> qualify for services under the McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act:

- > an emergency or transitional shelter
- hotel/motel due to loss of housing
- ➤ in a house or apartment with another family because of loss of housing, economic hardship, or other similar reason
- > an abandoned building, car, park, on the street, or campsite
- > in substandard housing (lacking heat, electricity, running water, mold)

If you live in one of these situations, Texas State Law guarantees that the student can enroll in school without having to provide any of the following documentation:

Proof of residency
Immunization records
Birth Certificate
School Records
Legal guardianship records
