### <u>Audition Rehearsals and Auditions – Rules and Procedures</u>

Audition rehearsals and auditions are scheduled at the dates and times below. Rehearsals and auditions are closed to the public.

No later than the beginning of the first audition rehearsal candidates shall turn in all completed forms listed below. Failure to do so shall result in the candidate being disqualified from auditioning for the drill team.

Candidates auditioning are required to attend all audition rehearsals and the audition. Only a medical emergency will be accepted as an excuse by the director. Audition rehearsals are closed to all observers except for the school district administrators, the tabulator, dance directors and dance routine instructors.

As specified by the director, candidates should wear a black leotard or form-fitting shirt, black tights or jazz pants, and ballet/jazz/lyrical dance shoes to both the audition and audition rehearsal. All hair should be in a ponytail. Make-up should be worn (darker than usual), with red lipstick and NO jewelry (to include jewelry worn in piercings), glitter or nail polish other than clear. No visible tattoos. No chewing gum, No unnatural hair color. No gauges.

At the first audition rehearsal, candidates will be grouped. Prior to the audition date, candidates will receive a scheduled time for their group.

When candidates arrive for their audition, they will be assigned a number which shall be attached to the front of the leotard using safety pins. The number shall not be altered or defaced in any manner. As soon as the numbers are distributed, candidates are to gather in their pre-assigned groups and begin stretching.

NOTE: Falsification or alterations of records shall result in disqualification and loss of membership from the drill team for the year affected by the audition.

#### **Audition Scoring**

- 1. Scoring during the audition shall be based on a 100 point scale using the following criteria: (see scoring rubric, pg. 10-11)
  - a. Body Awareness 5 pts
  - b. Kicks 10 pts
  - c. Dance Technique 10 pts
  - d. Stage Presence 10 pts
  - e. Leaps 10 pts
  - f. Turns 10 pts
  - g. Musicality 5 pts

- h. Memory 10 pts \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ 70 pts
- i. Academic Record 10 pts
- j. Campus Discipline Review 10 pts
- k. Director Review of Practice 10 pts

- 2. Designated personnel shall tabulate each candidate's total score.
- 3. Either three or four judges may be engaged.
- 4. Placement on the line will be determined through the judges' combined scores. The combined scores will be placed in rank order. Placement on the varsity line will be determined by the first natural break in rank scores. Placement on the junior varsity line will be determined by the second natural break in rank scores.
- Application form, Academic, and Campus Discipline Records-The candidate's application form, academic (last report card) and campus discipline records for the year shall be reviewed by the judges.
- Director Review of Practice The director will monitor and rate each candidate on the ability to receive feedback and constructive criticism. Scores shall be given to the tabulator before the audition begins.
- 7. Score sheets will be retained by each campus for **two years** following the audition. At the end of the two year period, all scores which have not been requested for viewing will be destroyed.

### **Further Information for Parents and Students**

### <u>Tryout Eligibility and Transfers</u>

Candidates must be currently enrolled at a Killeen ISD campus to be eligible to participate in tryouts. Candidates must tryout at the campus in their attendance zone unless a transfer form is filed and approved prior to tryouts. A drill team member transferring to another KISD high school after auditions shall not be eligible for membership in the receiving high school's drill team.

### **Drill Team Responsibility Agreement**

- 1) I understand that if my student is accepted as a member of the drill team, my student will be required to enroll in and attend the designated drill team class while serving as a member of the team.
- 2) I understand and agree to the time requirements and financial responsibilities listed below:
  - a) The team will start training and practicing in the summer at a time designated by the director. Failure to attend will result in removal from the team.
  - b) Practices are held during the year before or after school as designated by the director. An occasional practice during the weekend may be called.
  - c) A field uniform shall be issued by the school.
  - d) Estimated cost for the year shall not exceed the district cap.
  - e) The team may do fundraising projects to help defray costs.
  - f) Each member shall attend a mandatory summer camp, date, time and location to be designated by the director. Failure to attend will result in removal from the team.
  - g) Each member is expected to stay in peak physical condition and will need to practice and stretch on their own. A 100% effort is required at all practices and performances. Since it is an extracurricular activity, membership in drill team is a privilege, not a right.
- 3) My student and I understand that all drill team members have room for improvement. If my student does not meet the expectation for any performance, my student will not perform with the group. The director's decision is final.
- 4) Drill team is a very active program. If selected for the team, my student shall attend summer camp, participate actively throughout football season, travel to several competitions, and perform in the spring show
- 5) My student and I understand that an after school job does not qualify as an excused absence.
- 6) My student understands that grades and attendance are extremely important. Passing grades must be maintained in order to continue to be eligible to participate as a drill team member.
- 7) My student shall behave responsibly at all times, and show respect to others.
- 8) My student shall look neat, organized and well-groomed at all times.
- 9) My student understands commitment to a team, and that the needs of the team supersede the needs of the individual.
- 10) Failure to participate in a full year of activities shall result in dismissal from the team.
- 11) If chosen as a member of the drill team, my student promises to uphold the rules, procedures and constitution of the drill team, and to fulfill any financial responsibilities. My student promises to be mindful of obligations, and committed to making the organization the best it can be.
- 12) My student will be a model of good behavior at school, at performances, and at home.
- 13) Failure to abide by the drill team rules, procedures, constitution, and the Killeen ISD Student Code of Conduct shall result in dismissal from the organization.
