

Approved Elementary Rezoning to Relieve Reeces Creek

- Last year, a new wing addition became operational and increased Reeces Creek's building planning capacity to 984 students.
- On their peak enrollment date this year, Reeces Creek was 155 over their building's planning capacity, requiring the use of portable building classrooms.
- Reeces Creek's current attendance zone still has available lots in existing subdivisions that may yield at least 75 more students over time.
- The rezoned area will be eligible for bussing to Saegert elementary.
- Current year 4th graders will be given the opportunity to grandfather back to Reeces Creek to finish their last year, if desired. Siblings of grandfathered students will be given the opportunity to attend the same school as their older siblings. For both options, parents/students are responsible for transportation. These options fall under the district's transfer policy, which can be revoked due to attendance or discipline issues. Please note that the grandfathering and sibling transfer provisions are forfeited if a student decides to return to their zoned campus or withdraws from Killeen ISD.
- Rezoning Map – the background color coding indicates current attendance zones; the heavy, red lines indicate the area being rezoned
- Street Listings of Affected Areas – a list of addresses in the affected areas.
- The rezoning map provides a visual representation of the following changes. The region bounded by the area described below is currently zoned to Reeces Creek but will move to Saegert beginning with the 2015-16 school year.
 - Zone 377
 - South of the Rahman and Trimmier Estates subdivisions
 - East of SH 195 / Fort Hood Rd.
 - West of Trimmier Rd.
 - North of Charles E. Patterson MS
