## **Prekindergarten 3 Round-Up!**



**Preregistration April 24-26 2017 from 9am-2pm at student's home campus**

### Eligibility

A child must meet the following conditions to be eligible for this full-day prekindergarten program:

- Student must be 3 (three) years old on or before September 1, 2017 AND
- Student must be a biological child, adopted child or step child of a military member who is on Active Duty, is MIA or was killed or injured during active military duty (includes activated Texas National Guard and all activated Reserves) AND
- Student must reside in the attendance zone of the on-post school they will attend (special consideration transfers may be approved but are evaluated on a case-by-case basis by Student Services)

### Required Documents

- **Active Duty Military ID**, DEERS form, or other reliable documentation that the child is a dependent of an **active duty** military member
- Picture ID of the parent or guardian enrolling the student
- LES or proof of income within the last 30 days to determine qualification for free or reduced breakfast/lunch (if applicable)
- Official birth certificate
- Proof of residency on Fort Hood
- Current immunization records
- Student's Social Security card

### About the Program

- Full day
- Free of charge
- School Supply lists will be available at the student's home campus
- All qualifying students will be allowed to attend school, regardless of when they register. This program is not based on first come, first served
- Before and after-school care: Child & Youth Services (CYS)
- Certified teachers and trained paraprofessionals
- Research based curriculum

## **Pre-kindergarten 4 Round-Up!**

**Preregistration April 24-26 2017 from 9am-2pm at student's home campus**

### Eligibility

A child must meet the following conditions to be eligible for this full-day Pre-kindergarten program:

*Student must be 4 (four) years old on or before September 1, 2017 AND student must meet one of the following conditions:*

- Speaks another language besides English at home, has a qualifying score on an Oral Language Proficiency Test and identified as ELL by the LPAC; qualification under this criteria is provisional until an LPAC is held
- Eligible for free/reduced lunch program (income level based)
- Qualifying Military Dependent—**Active Duty Military ID**, DEERS form, or other reliable documentation to show that the child is a dependent of an **Active Duty Military** member or a dependent of a prior military member who was injured, killed or MIA while on active duty; simply being a retired military member does NOT meet this criteria
- Has ever been under the conservatorship (foster care) of the Department of Family and Protective Services (DFPS) following an adversary hearing

NOTE: The Interstate Compact for Military Students (ICMS) does not cover eligibility for Pre-kindergarten enrollment

### Required Documents

- Official birth certificate
- Proof of residency (last 30 days)
- Current immunization records
- Picture ID of the parent or guardian enrolling the student
- Student's Social Security card
- Proof of income for the last 30 days (if applicable)

### About the Program

- Full day
- All qualifying students will be allowed to attend school, regardless of when they register. This program is not based on first come, first served
- School Supply lists will be available at the student's home campus
- Before and after-school care for **off-post** schools: Armed Services YMCA (ASYMCA)
- Before and after-school care for **on-post** schools: Child & Youth Services (CYS)
- Certified teachers and trained paraprofessionals

## **Kindergarten Round-Up!**

**Preregistration April 24-26 2017 from 9am-2pm at student's home campus**

### Eligibility

- A child entering kindergarten must be 5 (five) years old on or before September 1, 2017
- Students may be older than 5, but not younger
- Being enrolled in kindergarten in another district, state or country has no influence on eligibility in Texas, except for those who meet the eligibility requirements of the Interstate Compact for Military Students (ICMS)

### Required Documents

- Official birth certificate
- Proof of residency (last 30 days)
- Current immunization records
- Picture ID of the parent or guardian enrolling the student
- Student's Social Security card
- If your child is an underage kindergartner who meets the provision of the Military Interstate Compact you will need to contact your child's home campus for required documentation prior to registration

### About the Program

If the student's KISD kindergarten preregistration packet has been returned to their home campus then there is no need to attend this activity, they will be preregistered for kindergarten by the campus.

- Before and after-school care for **off-post** schools: Armed Services YMCA (ASYMCA)
- Before and after-school care for **on-post** schools: Child & Youth Services (CYS)
- Certified teachers and trained paraprofessionals
