The Leadership Academy is a focus program of the C.E. Ellison High School. It is an association of select high performing students who strive to combine their individual talents to improve themselves, their school, and the community. Members learn by doing, attending required monthly leadership seminars and Academy committee meetings, working with a mentor in the community to learn about a profession, completing an independent project, and contributing community service. Members are required to take the Principals of Leadership curriculum, complete 50 hours of community service each year, complete a senior leadership project.

As enrolled into the Academy, each student will have to take one leadership course each year to remain in the academy. Freshman students will be enrolled in the PGPA Leadership course. Sophomore students will be enrolled in PBR Leadership course. Juniors and Seniors will participate in a career shadowing course requiring 10 hours of active shadowing per week. *Note, students may still participate in other activities/organizations as Athletics, STEM, Career Center, etc.*

Students who remain in the academy upon 4 completed years of the curriculum, community service, and projects will receive a leadership stole for graduation. Students who do not meet the 4-year requirement by joining a year late or not completing their hours have the opportunity of receiving a lettermen jacket, patches, etc.

Eligibility Requirements:

- GPA of at least 2.75(see counselor for guidance)
- No serious attendance or discipline referrals

Application Process:

- 1. Complete and attach all required document(s).
- 2. Return the completed application to <u>holly.ponce@killeenisd.org</u> or Ellison High School Counselors Office.
- 3. When the application is received, an interviewed will be scheduled.
- 4. Upon interview, more information will be given out then.

* If a student requires a transfer to Ellison High School, transportation is **NOT** provided. *
