Dear Parents or Guardians:

The Killeen Independent School District is scheduled to open a new elementary school in the Fall of 2019. This new school will be located in the southeast quadrant of the school district, in the White Rock subdivision. When a new school is opened an attendance boundary must be established. Creating a new attendance zone causes changes to existing attendance zones. New attendance zones for several elementary schools impacted by the creation of a zone for the new elementary school have been proposed to the school board. The school board, in turn, has authorized the administration to hold hearings on the proposed changes so that input from families who will be affected can be gathered. Please consider attending the hearing as scheduled below so that we can explain the zoning proposal, receive your input, and ultimately present that input to the school board prior to any official action being taken on attendance zones for the 2019-2020 school year.

Our records indicate that your residence is in an area that will be impacted by the proposed attendance zone changes associated with the opening of Maude Moore Wood Elementary School for the 2019-2020 school year. Community input is vital to this important decision. Please attend one of the following hearings:

Tuesday, February 19 at 5:30 pm in the Alice W. Douse ES cafeteria

Wednesday, February 20 at 5:30 pm in the Skipcha ES cafeteria

Thursday, February 21 at 5:30 pm in the Timber Ridge ES cafeteria

Parents are encouraged to attend any of the scheduled meetings. A map indicating the proposed changes is enclosed. Maps will be available at each meeting.

If your child is attending another campus on an approved transfer, you must complete a new application each year to remain at that campus. If your child is at another campus for a special program, you will be notified separately of any special program changes due to this rezoning. The district is making a concerted effort to minimize location changes of special programs.
